### Heavy Fleet Overhaul Saves West Valley City Taxpayers Hundreds of Thousands of Dollars

A decision to prolong the life span of some of West Valley City's hardest-working vehicles is expected to save taxpayers more than half a million dollars over the next two years. The heavy fleet overhaul plan, implemented this year, aims to refurbish rather than replace six large vehicles in the city's fleet, realizing a savings of approximately \$100,000 per vehicle.

The idea to refurbish rather than replace was presented by West Valley City's Fleet Manager, Eric Madsen, who oversees the city's fleet of more than 500 vehicles. "The cabs and chassis on these

trucks are in great shape," says Madsen. "Replacing the beds, hydraulics and plows – the parts that see the most wear and tear – will give these trucks another six-to-eight years of life."

Madsen says innovative cost-saving ideas are a priority of Public Works Director Russ Willardson. "It's really not hard to disagree with a good idea," says Willardson. "The engines on these trucks still have a lot of life in them and it makes perfect sense to keep them on the road, especially when the savings are this significant."
