
## Christmas Tree Disposal



Dumpsters will be placed at City Park (4500 West 3500 South) and at West View Park (6100 West 4100 South) through January 16 for Christmas Tree disposal. Residents may bring trees (no lights, stands, nails, screws, bags or decorations) to place in the dumpsters. No artificial trees will be accepted and no other trash is allowed in the dumpsters. Trees will be recycled and used as mulch throughout the city.


