Help Prevent Stormwater Pollution



Spring is around the corner, and improving weather has many West Valley City residents anxious to get outside and work in their yards. As you begin to think about spring cleaning and yardwork remember that in addition to keeping the city clean and maintaining property values, proper maintenance and upkeep can prevent hazardous materials from entering the city's storm drain system.

Stormwater run off (rain and snow melt) carries pollutants, metals, toxins, oils and grease, litter, leaves, grass clippings, fertilizers and pesticides into the nearby storm drain. This water is not treated before it enters the Jordan River, Decker Lake and other waterways throughout the city.

Please be aware of the following best practices as you maintain your property:

- Sweep the driveway and sidewalk, never hose them down
- Bag and dispose of pet waste
- Limit use of fertilizers and pesticides
- Wash your car at a commercial car wash or on the lawn

- Prevent oil spills and maintain vehicles
- Sweep up grass clippings
- Clean out curb in front of your home
- Plant bare ground
- Empty pool and spa water into a household drain
- Never dump anything down the storm drain

Because pollutants entering the storm drain system present several risks to the health, welfare and safety of the public and the environment, it is illegal for anyone to dump potentially hazardous materials into a storm drain -- even if unintentionally. These hazardous materials may include yard debris, petroleum, chemicals, paints, pesticides, herbicides, detergents, metals, acids, solid and liquid waste, and human or animal waste. Violations may result in citations, penalties and fines.
