## Pets are part of your family.

Keep them **licensed**. Keep them **safe**. Keep them **home**.

It's as simple as leaving a gate or front door open. In an instant, part of the family is gone. Help us bring them safely home by licensing your pets.

### How does licensing help?

1. If a lost pet is brought to the animal shelter by a resident, we can quickly look up the tag number and contact the owner for a quick reunion. In 2015, we reunited 901 lost pets with their owners.
2. If a resident finds a loose animal, we can contact the owner and arrange for a reunion.
3. If an Animal Control Officer finds a loose pet, they can find the pet's home and return it without ever bringing it to the shelter. This reduces your pet's exposure to disease and other animals.
4. If your pet has medical issues, they can be indicated on the license, protecting them if they get loose and you are not reachable.
5. If your pet is licensed we can record their microchip number on their license, and get in touch with you much quicker than calling microchip company for the information first.

**Dogs, cats, ferrets and pot-bellied pigs are required to be licensed in West Valley City; dogs, cats and ferrets must be licensed in Taylorsville.**

## UDOT Project to Impact 4700 South



The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will be resurfacing S.R. 266 (4700 South) from I-15 to I-215 West to increase the life of the roadway. Construction is scheduled to begin mid-April and continue through July 2016. Surrounding residents and businesses can expect traffic restrictions, construction equipment and vehicles, and an increase in noise.
