Councilmember Burt read a Proclamation declaring November 1, 2010, as “Extra Mile Day” in West Valley City.

15115      **COMMENT PERIOD**

Upon inquiry by Mayor Winder, the following individuals addressed the City Council during the comment period:

Fynbo (no first name given), 4160 West 3830 South, addressed the City Council. Fynbo complimented the street maintenance crew and expressed appreciation for the repairs in his neighborhood.

Janet Ericson, 4498 West 4695 South, addressed the City Council. Ms. Ericson thanked City Recorder, Sheri McKendrick, for responding to her request and sending a copy of the minutes of the meeting at which the City Council approved a resolution declaring their intent to hold a General Obligation Bond Election for parks and trails, Proposition #3 on the ballot. Ms. Ericson stated she was against Proposition #3.

15116      **ORDINANCE NO. 10-33, AMEND SECTION 23-3-101 OF TITLE 23 OF THE WEST VALLEY CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TO RESOLVE A CONFLICT BETWEEN TITLE 7 AND TITLE 23 OF THE WEST VALLEY CITY MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE NUMBER OF LICENSED PETS ALLOWED PER HOUSEHOLD**

City Manager, Wayne Pyle, presented proposed Ordinance No. 10-33 which would amend Section 23-3-101 of Title 23 of the West Valley City Municipal Code to resolve a conflict between Title 7 and Title 23 of the West Valley City Municipal Code regarding the number of licensed pets allowed per household.

Mr. Pyle stated Section 7-1-103(101) allowed for a total of four licensed animals in all zones where pets were allowed and animal control ordinance 23-1-101(6)

allowed for two licensed animals. He indicated the proposed change would eliminate Section 23-1-101(6) allowing Section 7-1-103(101) to control the number of pets allowed on a property.

Mr. Pyle also stated cats had not been required to be licensed under City ordinance for several years and now were required to be licensed under Section 23-3-101(1), which put Section 23-3-101(6) in conflict with Section 7-1-103(101).

After discussion, Councilmember Buhler moved to approve Ordinance No. 10-33, an Ordinance Amending Section 23-3-101 of Title 23 of the West Valley City Municipal Code to Resolve a Conflict between Title 7 and Title 23 of the West Valley City Municipal Code Regarding the Number of Licensed Pets Allowed per Household. Councilmember Christensen seconded the motion.
