



STREET SAFETY

- Do not park vehicles, boats, trailers or any other personal property on the street when snow is possible. Vehicles on the road while there is an accumulation of snow or ice of one inch or more may be ticketed or towed.
- If you must pile snow at the end of your driveway, be sure to place the snow on the down-stream side of the drive.
- Plow drivers have large areas, with multiple travel lanes, that must be cleared each storm. Main roads are always plowed first, followed by secondary or connecting streets. Subdivisions are plowed next and finally cul-de-sacs and dead ends. Please be patient.
- When you find yourself following plows, please stay back farther than normal. When two or more trucks are plowing in tandem, do not attempt to pass, this could result in an accident.
- Please understand that our drivers take care not to bury sidewalks and driveways when plowing your street; accidents do happen, however.

SIDEWALK SAFETY

- It is the property owner's responsibility to clear all sidewalks abutting their property of hail, snow, or sleet. Sidewalks should be cleaned before 8 a.m. the morning following a storm.
- It is unlawful to place snow, dirt, etc. in a gutter or prevent free flow of water in the gutter.
