Mobile Patrol is a group of trained citizens who want to stop crime in their neighborhoods by being the “eyes and ears” of the West Valley City Police Department. Like the traditional neighborhood watch, mobile patrol groups report any crime and suspicious activity to the Police and their neighbors. The purpose of citizen mobile patrol is to assist in deterring crime. These citizens also help educate their communities about good safety practices.

Some things to remember about mobile patrol:

- Participants **only** patrol the boundaries of their registered Neighborhood Watch group.
- Participants **must be** at least 18 years of age.
- Participants **ALWAYS** patrol in teams. NEVER ALONE.
- Participants work with a volunteer in their neighborhood to set their own **schedules**.
- Participants are **required** to attend training provided by West Valley City a minimum of once every two years.
- Participants are **NOT** representatives of the Police or City, they are acting as community volunteers.
- Participants do **NOT** have police authority.
- Participants are **responsible** and liable for their own safety and actions at all times.
- Participants should **NOT** leave their vehicle to confront suspects.
- Participants should **NOT** carry or use weapons such as firearms, nightsticks, mace, clubs, etc.
